Immediately following the nominations meeting there will be a candidates' meeting to discuss the election and campaign rules

A secret ballot election of Local 1235 officers will be conducted at the date, time and place indicated below:

All absentee ballots must be received at the designated post office no later than 5:00 PM on October 2, 2018.
